Summer Energy Saving Tips

Use these cool tips to help you beat the heat and save energy and money this summer.

 Replace air filters monthly.

Clear outdoor air

conditioning units of debris and shrubbery so they work more efficiently.

• Use shades, drapes and blinds to keep the sun and heat out.

• Set the air conditioning thermostat to 78.

• Change incandescent lights to cooler fluorescent lights.

• Use fans to feel cooler, but turn them off when you leave the room.

• Use the microwave or grill outdoors instead of the oven or stove.

• Clean the dust from the coils and motor of your refrigerator to help it run cooler. Dates: June 18 and July 15
